(Root Directory)		Contains Setup.exe , the to the CTI Server Setup Checklist, C:\Flare\Installation\Library\Documentation_Library.msi installer.
Additional CTI Modules	-	Contains additional CTI Server Application Suite Modules. For more information regarding the additional modules that are available, refer to the Installation -> Installing Additional Modules section of the NEC Library .
CTISoftware	-	Contains the core CTI Server Installer.
InstallationDoc	-	Contains the CTI Server Setup Checklist documentation and wizard help files.
Integration Modules	-	Contains the modules required to integrate Unified Communications for Business with various third party software.
Library	-	Contains the NEC Library installer. The NEC Library is the documentation repository for the Unified Communications for Business product suite.
Prerequisites	AdbeRdr811_en_US.exe	This executable contains the Adobe Reader application. This application is automatically installed by the CTI Server Setup Checklist.
	DataImport.xls	This file contains an Excel version of the Data Import Wizard import template. This file can be used to create a .CSV file, which can then be used to import user data into the system. For more information about the Data Import wizard, refer to the Wizards -> System Setup Wizards -> Import Data Wizard section of the Administrator online help.
	dotnetfx.exe	This executable contains the Microsoft .NET 2.0 Framework , which is automatically installed by the CTI Server Setup Checklist.
	vcredist_2005_sp1_x86.exe	This executable contains the Visual C++ Redistributable , which is automatically installed by the CTI Server Setup Checklist
	WindowsInstaller-KB884016-v2-x86.exe	This executable contains the redistributable package for installing or upgrading Windows Installer 3.0.
Prerequisites\Aculab	-	Contains the Aculab 6.4 Prosody S driver. This driver is installed automatically by the CTI Server Setup Checklist and is required if you using a SV8100 PBX, or any other PBX that is running the Executive Conference module.
Prerequisites\TSP Installer	-	Contains the NEC Infrontia Telephony Driver .
TelephonyWebServices	-	Contains the installation files for the Web Portal and Executive Mobile modules.
Tools	-	Contains additional tools which may be used by an installer or Administrator during the CTI Server installation process.
